

**NORTHERN CALIFORNIA

PLEASURE RIDING AWARD**

PURPOSE: To encourage members who don't compete with their horse, or don't yet own a horse.

AWARDS: Champion and Reserve will be awarded to the two individuals recording the most hours pleasure riding.

MEMBERS: The individual must be a paid member before any points will be counted.

POINTS: All hours spent in non-competitive enjoyment of an American Saddlebred may be counted including riding lessons. A description of the hours must be sent to Sue Valley, 20 Inverrary Lane, Alamo CA 94507, or faxed to 925-831-1446 or E-mailed to susanvalley@mac.com by October 15. Any hours sent after that date will be counted toward the following years awards. Even though the final tally of points is not due until October 15, you must notify Susan Valley of the intent to compete for this award by September 1 at the latest. One point will be given for each hour.

The name of the horse must be submitted along with the hours. If you are not the owner, list the owner's name as well.
